The following documents are **required** to support this application:

Candidate:

- Letter of Intent (cover letter)
- Proof of Canadian Citizenship or Landed Immigrant Status
- Curriculum vitae
- Research Proposal (maximum 2 pages)
- Disclosure of funding from other sources (**candidates are not permitted to hold a second award exceeding \$10,000**)
- Each application must include a photo and 150 word biosketch

Additional Documentation Required:

- Letter of support from the Program Director of the current residency training program
- Letter of support from the Fellowship Supervisor, including description of fellowship training program, its aims and the environment.
- Letter of acceptance from the post graduate program or fellowship program
- An additional letter of reference

Letter of Support should:

- Describe nature of association with the applicant.
- Comment on items such as candidate's written and verbal communication skills, perseverance in pursuing goals, self-reliance and independence in clinical practice and learning, clinical proficiency, research ability and overall academic potential as these skills relate to the applicant's chosen path of study.
- Should attest that the candidate either does not have an alternative source of funding or will forfeit the alternative funding in favor of the CLAE award if successful in this application.
